## Fourteenth Sunday: Year C



*Fr. Mark writes:* Throughout the Gospel we see Our Lord making provision for the ministry of the Church, which will continue to call into unity all mankind until that time when Christ returns in glory. Today He extends this duty beyond the original Twelve and commissions “seventy-two others” to heal the sick and preach the Good News. It seems almost reckless for God to entrust His mission to mere mortals. We know that even His closest associates will get things badly wrong, even betray Him. Yet that is what He chose to do – and what He continues to choose to do to this day. He invites ordinary human beings to work with Him, strengthening

With grace, leaving them His example to follow. “The labourers are few.” Let us pray people of our own day respond to His call to join Him in bringing home the harvest to the Father.
